




# 5. Childproof Lid

Using the screw provided, fasten the lid via the hole beneath the rim of the water butt.



It is possible to connect two Little Tree Water Butts together.

The Little Tree Water Butt is delivered with a full kit including a brass tap and wall bracket. To fill the Little Tree, we recommend using the optional 3P Filter Collector Universal.

Where the water butt cannot be located within 30 cm of the down pipe, longer Universal Long Link Kits are available online (Art. No. 9000123U, U2, to U5).





### 1. Setting up

Site the Little Tree on a firm, level surface, adjacent to the downpipe.

Refer to your Filter Collector instructions or other rain diverter instructions. Connecting a tap is optional.




Screw the 3/4" brass tap provided in the kit into the 3/4" BSP connection thread. If necessary, use PTFE tape when installing the tap to create a more watertight seal and to ensure the tap sits in the correct position.




### 2. Fitting an (optional) 3P Filter Collector with Universal Link Kit

Measure down 90 mm from the lip of the water butt. This position is ideal for all connections of 32 mm (1 1/4") or less.



To fill the water butt with the recommended 3P Universal Filter Collector. select the 32 mm flat bit from the set provided.







A back nut and rubber seal may be fitted. Hold the back nut and rubber seal on the inside of the hole and screw on the hose tail.

# 4. Winter Care Precautions

To prevent any damage from being caused, the Timberly must be completely drained disconnected from the rainwater inlet during freezing weather conditions.
